Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizes of hook type blade carriages rated by the blade carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type tine carriages have been the same.

The carriage bar spacing used for Class 1 is something like thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold cargo up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted blades differ by the amount of offset between the tine and the tine eye. Different manufacturers would differ the carriages for pin type tines. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
