When this step has been finished, all of the parts are checked to see if they have any defects, any breakage or any extensive wear. Particular parts like for instance cylinder heads, crankshafts, cylinder blocks and connecting rods are resurfaced, resized and reground if considered necessary. Various parts like for instance nuts, bolts, gears et cetera. are replaced or repaired as considered necessary.
