

Fork Mounted Buckets

Fork Mounted Bucket - Whenever businesses calculate all their expenditures and want to reduce overhead, unnecessary machinery rentals and acquisitions are the very first thing to be eliminated. Numerous construction businesses feel that loaders have become a cumbersome expenditure and many of their jobs can be accomplished using the versatility and effectiveness offered by lift truck buckets.

A forklift bucket could be purchased for much less than it actually costs to rent a loader for several months. It would transform your extendable reach forklift into a material handling and loading piece of equipment that operates efficiently. This setup would offer increased range as opposed to typical loaders and have more adaptability in general. There are different forklift buckets obtainable used for specific applications.

Universal Fit Buckets

"Slip on the forks" accessory buckets or otherwise called Universal Fit buckets can be used along with whichever design or model of extendable reach lift truck. If your unit is unable to be matched with a quick-tach unit, another new or used universal fit bucket could be located in its place. Standard universal lift truck buckets connect to blades that are up to 6" wide and are 48" long. Bigger fork pockets can be ordered through an account manager upon request.

Since they slip directly onto the blades, universal fit buckets stay on the equipment and are less susceptible to damage. Compared to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are 50% deeper. This additional room makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads such as moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing of roof trash and elevating roof gravel.

Quick-Tach Buckets

Quick-Tach Buckets are constructed for extendable-reach forklifts. They are made to allow placement of material far beyond the reach of a loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on the leading edge and on both sides reinforces stability, resistance to wear and tear and provides supreme durability. Quick-Tach forklift buckets are enhanced by scuff bars along the base of the unit which protect it from scrapes.

Quick-Tach lift buckets could in many cases replace the forks and carriage of a forklift, that may weigh anywhere between 100-700lbs. These buckets when set up could free up more load capacity, enabling it to handle both bigger and heavier things. The Quick-Tach can dump things more or less 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket. These buckets are fabricated in a custom fashion so as to suit the specifications of particular models and makes of forklifts.
