Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine shop employing just 4 individuals. Total sales for that initial year totaled \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Through 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to 40 employees and their annual sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. These days, Cascade is among the top global producers in the material handling industry.

Design and production of the company's first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively engage in new business opportunities. Throughout the final sixty years, the trade of material handling has grown into a really advanced field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its improvement. Cascade presently continues to grow as the leader supplier of forklift accessories and different associated items. The company feels assured in their ability so as to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding buyer's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive within the world market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade began designing, fabricating and selling hydraulic accessories. Construction was finished in the year 1956 on a new facility to accommodate all the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present headquarters. Following 15 years of business, total employees reached a hundred and eighty staff and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next production plant was built. 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

The business changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. The business has expanded its manufacturing plants within the United States with places in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, Ohio, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade products are manufactured internationally thanks to a lot of subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new facility was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This plant is built to be the essential customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 after acquiring 5 companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global best in forks.
